RE: **Important Notice** – Multiple Peril Crop Insurance Policy for crop year 2024

Your federally reinsured Multiple Peril Crop Insurance (“MPCI”) policy is currently serviced by Crop Risk Services, Inc. (“Crop Risk Services”) and issued by Stratford Insurance Company (“Stratford”), an approved insurance provider, or “AIP”, in the federal crop insurance program. As an AIP, Stratford issues MPCI policies pursuant to a Standard Reinsurance Agreement (“SRA”) between it and the Federal Crop Insurance Corporation.

Why am I getting this notice?

Crop Risk Services was purchased by an affiliate of Great American Insurance Company (“Great American”), an Ohio based insurance company that also delivers MPCI as an AIP on July 3, 2023. Under the terms of the sale, Crop Risk Services will continue to service your MPCI policy issued under the Stratford SRA for the 2023 crop year and prior years.

For the 2024 crop year (that is, for MPCI policies with a sales closing date after July 1, 2023), your MPCI policy will be issued by Stratford and serviced by Crop Risk Services under the Great American SRA.

What do I need to do?

You do not need to do anything at this time to continue your current coverage. This change in crop year 2024 simply means that Stratford will be issuing your MPCI policy pursuant to Great American’s SRA. Your agent will remain the same and your policy will continue to be serviced by Crop Risk Services.
