What is Environmental Liability Insurance?

- Environmental insurance is intended to fill the coverage gaps created by pollution exclusions in general liability and property insurance policies.
- Since the 1970s, many state and federal pollution laws have been created to help protect the environment and create liability standards for environmental cleanups.

Why is Environmental Liability Important?

- While environmental issues may occur less frequently, they are often
 massive, expensive, and complex. Within essentially every industry, there
 is at least one pollution exposure which means that the environmental
 liability insurance industry is constantly evolving and growing.
- Too many policyholders assume that the pollution coverage in general liability (GL) policies provides sufficient protection, when in fact there is limited to no coverage for pollution.
- As landlords, attorneys, and lenders are increasingly requiring pollution coverage (e.g., lease agreements, transactions, loan requirements), it's vital as a broker to present environmental liability insurance options to your clients in order to help protect against possible future E&O claims.
